

e-Posters uploading instructions.

The poster presentation will be a flash three-minute presentation/video and a poster in pdf format. The link to view it is provided to the delegates onsite using a QR code. This same QR code takes one to the digital abstract book with the programme and abstracts, and you have a folder with all the e-posters.

Presenting authors must prepare two files for each poster:

a) E-Poster File (PDF document)

1. Posters must be in a landscape orientation in A0 format.
2. Poster must be submitted in PDF format and must be named with the presenting authors family name and first name.
3. Review your presentation slide on a different computer from the one it was originally prepared on to ensure everything works properly.
4. Slides (.ppt, .pptx) – max 30 MB

b) Flash presentation

1. Format of the presentation: (no longer than 3 minutes)
2. Narrated single image with audio track (MP4 or MOV)
3. MP4 or MOV pre-recorded presentation file

Where to upload the two files:

- The e-poster (pdf document) and the flash presentation must be uploaded to the Dropbox <https://www.dropbox.com/request/7QymnXdCptG89HjN7h4X>
- Deadline to upload: 8 September 2023. **Uploading after this date will not be possible.**
- Both files must be named as follows: **Abstract number**, presenting authors **family name and first name**.
- Delegates can view the e-posters presentation and pdf formatted poster, online at two kiosks with large screens or view it online on their devices. No hardcopy posters will be accepted.
